Sunday, May 12, 2024 Sermon Scriptures

**<u>Genesis 1:27,28</u>** <u>27</u> And God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; **male and female He created them**. <u>28</u> And God blessed them; and God said to them, "**Be fruitful and multiply**, and fill the earth, and subdue it; and rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

<u>Genesis 3:20</u> Now the man called his wife's name Eve, because she was the mother of all {the} living.

<u>Genesis 9:1, 7</u> <u>1</u> And God blessed Noah and his sons and said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth. <u>7</u> "And as for you, be fruitful and multiply; Populate the earth abundantly and multiply in it."

**<u>1 Thessalonians 4:3</u>** For this is the will of God, your sanctification; {that is,} that you abstain from sexual immorality;

<u>Colossians 3:5</u> Therefore consider the members of your earthly body as dead to immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and greed, which amounts to idolatry.

<u>Matthew 19:9</u> "And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except for immorality, and marries another woman commits adultery."

<u>Matthews 1:18, 19</u> <u>18</u> Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows. When His mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to **be with child by the Holy Spirit**. <u>19</u> And Joseph her husband, **being a righteous man, and not wanting to disgrace her**, desired to put her away secretly.

<u>John 8:41</u> "You are doing the deeds of your father." They said to Him, "We were not born of fornication; we have one Father, {even} God."

<u>Acts 26:17, 18</u> 17 rescuing you from the *Jewish* people and from the Gentiles, to whom I am sending you, <u>18</u> to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'

**<u>1 John 1:9</u>** If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

<u>2 Corinthians 12:21</u> I am afraid that when I come again my God may humiliate me before you, and I may mourn over many of **those who have sinned in the past and not repented of the impurity, immorality and sensuality** which they have practiced.

<u>Galatians 6:1</u> Brethren, even if a man is caught in any trespass, you who are spiritual, restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness; {each one} looking to yourself, lest you too be tempted.

**John 15:12** "This is My commandment, **that you love one another**, just as I have loved you.

**<u>1 John 3:11</u>** For this is the message which you have heard from the beginning, **that we should love one another;** 

<u>Luke 6:37</u> "And **do not judge and you will not be judged**; and do not condemn, and you will not be condemned; pardon, and you will be pardoned.

**Exodus 20:12** "Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the LORD your God gives you.

**Ephesians 6:2** HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER (which is the first commandment with a promise),

**Exodus 21:15, 17 15** "And he who strikes his father or his mother shall surely be put to death. **17** "And he who curses his father or his mother shall surely be put to death.

**Deuteronomy 21:18-21** 18 "If any man has a stubborn and rebellious son who will not obey his father or his mother, and when they chastise him, he will not even listen to them, 19 then his father and mother shall seize him, and bring him out to the elders of his city at the gateway of his home town. 20 "And they shall say to the elders of his city, 'This son of ours is stubborn and rebellious, he will not obey us, he is a glutton and a drunkard.' 21 "Then all the men of his city shall stone him to death; so you shall remove the evil from your midst, and all Israel shall hear {of it} and fear.

<u>Deuteronomy 27:16</u> 'Cursed is he who dishonors his father or mother.' And all the people shall say, 'Amen.'

**Proverbs 23:22** Listen to your father who begot you, **And do not despise your mother** when she is old.

<u>Matthew 15:4-6</u> <u>4</u> "For God said, 'HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER,' and, 'HE WHO SPEAKS EVIL OF FATHER OR MOTHER, LET HIM BE PUT TO DEATH.' <u>5</u> "But you say, 'Whoever shall say to {his} father or mother, "Anything of mine you might have been helped by has been given {to God,} " <u>6</u> he is not to honor his father or his mother.' And {thus} you invalidated the word of God for the sake of your tradition.

<u>Matthew 10:37</u> "He who loves father or mother **more than Me is not worthy of Me**; and he who loves **son or daughter** more than Me is not worthy of Me.

<u>Matthew 12:46-50</u> <u>46</u> While He was still speaking to the multitudes, behold, His mother and brothers were standing outside, seeking to speak to Him. <u>47</u> And someone said to Him, "Behold, Your mother and Your brothers are standing outside seeking to speak to You." <u>48</u> But He answered the one who was telling Him and said, "Who is My mother and who are My brothers?" <u>49</u> And stretching out His hand toward His disciples, He said, "Behold, My mother and My brothers! <u>50</u> "For whoever does the will of My Father who is in heaven, he is My brother and sister and mother."

<u>**Proverbs 6:20</u>** My son, observe the commandment of your father, And do not forsake the teaching of your mother;</u>

**Proverbs 31:1** The words of King Lemuel, the oracle which his mother taught him.

<u>Proverbs 31:26-30</u> <u>26</u> She opens her mouth in wisdom, And the teaching of kindness is on her tongue. <u>27</u> She looks well to the ways of her household, And does not eat the bread of idleness. <u>28</u> Her children rise up and bless her; Her husband {also,} and he praises her, {saying:} <u>29</u> "Many daughters have done nobly, But you excel them all." <u>30</u> Charm is deceitful and beauty is vain, {But} a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised.

**<u>2 Timothy 1:5</u>** For I am mindful of the sincere faith within you, which first dwelt in your grandmother Lois, and your mother Eunice, and I am sure that {it is} in you as well.

**<u>1 Kings. 22:51-52</u>** <u>51</u> Ahaziah the son of Ahab became king over Israel in Samaria in the seventeenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and he reigned two years over Israel.

**<u>52</u>** And **he did evil in the sight of the LORD** and walked in the way of his father **and in the way of his mother** and in the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who caused Israel to sin.

<u>2 Chronicles 22:2,3</u> <u>2</u> Ahaziah {was} twenty-two years old when he became king, and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Athaliah, the granddaughter of Omri.

## **<u>3</u>** He also walked in the ways of the house of Ahab, for his mother was his counselor to do wickedly.

<u>Matthew 14:6-11</u> <u>6</u> But when Herod's birthday came, the daughter of Herodias danced before  $\{\text{them}\}\$  and pleased Herod.

<u>7</u> Thereupon he promised with an oath to give her whatever she asked.

**<u>8</u>** And having been prompted by her mother, she said, "Give me here on a platter the head of John the Baptist."

9 And although he was grieved, the king commanded {it} to be given because of his oaths, and because of his dinner guests.

**<u>10</u>** And he sent and had John beheaded in the prison.

**<u>11</u>** And his head was brought on a platter and **given to the girl; and she brought {it} to her mother.**
