Sermon Scriptures

Rom. 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Eccl. 11:9 ¶ Rejoice, young man, **during your childhood**, and let your heart be pleasant during the **days of young manhood**. And follow the impulses of your heart and the desires of your eyes. **Yet know that God will bring you to judgment for all these things.**

John 3:16-18 **16** ¶ “For God **so loved the world**, that He gave His only begotten Son, that **whoever believes in Him shall not perish**, but **have eternal life**. **17** “For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, **but that the world might be saved through Him**. **18** “**He who believes in Him is not judged**; he who does not believe has **been judged already**, because **he has not believed in** the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Matt. 19:13, 14 **13** ¶ Then *some* children were brought to Him so that He might lay His hands on them and pray; **and the disciples rebuked them**.

14 But Jesus said, “Let the children alone, and **do not hinder them from coming to Me**; for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these.”

Gen. 18:19 “For I have chosen him, **so that he may command his children** and his household after him to keep the way of the LORD by doing righteousness and justice, so that the LORD may bring upon Abraham what He has spoken about him.”

Deut. 4:10 “*Remember* the day you stood before the LORD your God at Horeb, when the LORD said to me, ‘Assemble the people to Me, that I may let them hear My words so **they may learn to fear Me** all the days they live on the earth, **and that they may teach their children.**’

Prov. 29:17 **Correct your son**, and he will give you comfort; He will also delight your soul.

Eph. 6:4 ¶ Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, **but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord**.

2 Kings 2:23, 24 **23** ¶ Then he went up from there to Bethel; and as he was going up by the way, **young lads came out from the city and mocked him** and said to him, “Go up, you baldhead; go up, you baldhead!”

2 Kings 2:24 When he looked behind him and saw them, **he cursed them in the name of the LORD**. Then two female bears **came out of the woods and tore up forty-two lads of their number**.

2 Pet. 3:9 The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is **patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish** but for all to come to repentance.

Eph. 6:1 ¶ Children, obey your parents **in the Lord, for this is right**.

Col. 3:20 Children, be obedient to your parents **in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord**.

Prov. 3:5-12 **5** Trust in the LORD with all your heart And do not lean on your own understanding. **6** In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He will make your paths straight. **7** Do not be wise in your own eyes; **Fear the LORD and turn away from evil.** **8** It will be healing to your body And refreshment to your bones. **9 Honor the LORD from your wealth** And from **the first of all** your produce; **10** So your barns will be filled with plenty And your vats will overflow with new wine. **11** My son, **do not reject the discipline of the LORD Or loathe His reproof,** **12** For **whom the LORD loves He reproveth,** Even as a father *corrects* the son in whom he delights.

Rom. 12:1, 2 **1** ¶ Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, **to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is** your spiritual service of worship. **2** And **do not be conformed to this world,** but be **transformed by the renewing of your mind,** so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

1 Pet. 5:5 You younger men, likewise, **be subject to your elders;** and all of you, **clothe yourselves with humility toward one another,** for **GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE.**

7 casting all your anxiety on Him, because He cares for you.

Psa. 119:9 ¶ How can a young man keep his way pure? **By keeping it according to Your word.**

Psa. 119:11 Your word I have treasured in my heart, **That I may not sin against You.**

Gen. 37:2 These are *the records of* the generations of Jacob. ¶ **Joseph, when seventeen years of age,** was pasturing the flock with his brothers while he was *still* a youth, along with the sons of Bilhah and the sons of Zilpah, his father's wives. **And Joseph brought back a bad report about them to their father.**

Gen. 37:11 His brothers were jealous of him, but his father kept the saying *in mind*.

Gen. 37:18 ¶ When they saw him from a distance and before he came close to them, **they plotted against him to put him to death.**

Gen. 37:25-28 **25** ¶ Then they sat down to eat a meal. And as they raised their eyes and looked, behold, a caravan of Ishmaelites was coming from Gilead, with their camels bearing aromatic gum and balm and myrrh, on their way **to bring them down to Egypt.** **26** Judah said to his brothers, “**What profit is it for us to kill our brother** and cover up his blood? **27** “**Come and let us sell him to the Ishmaelites** and not lay our hands on him, for he is our brother, our *own* flesh.” And his brothers listened *to him*. **28** Then some Midianite traders passed by, so they pulled *him* up and lifted Joseph out of the pit, and **sold him to the Ishmaelites for twenty shekels of silver. Thus they brought Joseph into Egypt.**

Gen. 42:21 Then they said to one another, “Truly we are guilty concerning our brother, because **we saw the distress of his soul when he pleaded with us**, yet we would not listen; **therefore this distress has come upon us.**”

Gen. 39:1-6 ¶ Now Joseph had been taken down to Egypt; and Potiphar, an Egyptian officer of Pharaoh, the captain of the bodyguard, bought him from the Ishmaelites, who had taken him down there. **2** **The LORD was with Joseph, so he became a successful man.** And he was in the house of his master, the Egyptian. **3** Now **his master saw that the LORD was with him and how the LORD caused all that he did to prosper** in his hand. **4** So Joseph found favor in his sight and **became his personal servant**; and he **made him overseer over his house, and all that he owned** he put in his charge. **5** It came about that from the time he made him overseer in his house and over all that he owned, **the LORD blessed the Egyptian’s house on account of Joseph**; thus the LORD’S blessing was upon all that he owned, in the house and in the field. **6** So he left everything he owned **in Joseph’s charge**; and with him *there* he did not concern himself with anything except the food which he ate. ¶ Now Joseph was handsome in form and appearance.

Gen. 39:7-12 **7** It came about after these events that **his master’s wife looked with desire at Joseph**, and she said, “Lie with me.” **8** **But he refused** and said to his master’s wife, “Behold, with me *here*, my master does not concern himself with anything in the house, and he has put all that he owns in my charge.

Gen. 39:9 “There is no one greater in this house than I, and he has withheld nothing from me except you, because you are his wife. **How then could I do this great evil and sin against God?”** **10** As she spoke to Joseph day after day, **he did not listen to her to lie beside her or be with her.** **11** Now it happened one day that he went into the house to do his work, and none of the men of the household was there inside.

Gen. 39:12 She caught him by his garment, saying, “Lie with me!” And he left his garment in her hand and fled, and went outside.

Gen. 41:39-44 **39** So Pharaoh said to Joseph, “Since God has informed you of all this, there is no one so discerning and wise as you are. **40** “You shall be over my house, and according to your command all my people shall do homage; only in the throne I will be greater than you.” **41** Pharaoh said to Joseph, “See, I have set you over all the land of Egypt.” **42** Then Pharaoh took off his signet ring from his hand and put it on Joseph’s hand, and clothed him in garments of fine linen and put the gold necklace around his neck. **43** He had him ride in his second chariot; and they proclaimed before him, “Bow the knee!” And he set him over all the land of Egypt. **44** Moreover, Pharaoh said to Joseph, “*Though* I am Pharaoh, yet without your permission no one shall raise his hand or foot in all the land of Egypt.”
