Sermon Scriptures

<u>John 5:28</u> "Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which all who are in the tombs will hear His voice, <u>29</u> and will come forth; those who did the good *deeds* to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil *deeds* to a resurrection of judgment.

<u>Isa. 64:6</u> For all of us have become like one who is unclean, And **all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment**; And all of us wither like a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.

Matt. 5:48 "Therefore you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.

Rom. 3:10 as it is written, "THERE IS NONE RIGHTEOUS, NOT EVEN ONE;

Rom. 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Rom. 5:18 \P So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men.

Rom. 3:20 because by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified in His sight; for through the Law *comes* the knowledge of sin.

<u>Gal. 2:16</u> nevertheless knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the Law; since by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified.

<u>John 3:16</u> ¶ "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Eph. 2:8, 9 8 For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; **9** not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Rom. 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

<u>James 2:20</u> But are you willing to recognize, you foolish fellow, that faith without works is useless?

<u>James 2:26</u> For just as the body without *the* spirit is dead, so also faith without works is dead.

Eph. 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

Matt. 5:16 "Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

<u>1 Tim. 2:9, 10 9</u> Likewise, *I want* women to adorn themselves with proper clothing, modestly and discreetly, not with braided hair and gold or pearls or costly garments, <u>10</u> but rather by means of good works, as is proper for women making a claim to godliness.

<u>1 Tim. 5:10</u> having a reputation for good works; and if she has brought up children, if she has shown hospitality to strangers, if she has washed the saints' feet, if she has assisted those in distress, and if she has devoted herself to every good work.

<u>1 Tim. 6:18</u> *Instruct them* to do good, **to be rich in good works**, to **be generous** and ready to share,

<u>Titus 2:7</u> in all things show yourself to **be an example of good deeds**, *with* purity in doctrine, dignified,

<u>Titus 2:14</u> who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, **zealous for good deeds**.

<u>Titus 3:8</u> This is a trustworthy statement; and concerning these things I want you to speak confidently, so that those who have believed God will be careful to engage in good deeds. These things are good and profitable for men.

<u>Titus 3:14</u> Our people must also **learn to engage in good deeds** to meet pressing needs, so that they will not be unfruitful.

Heb. 10:24 and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deed
